Presidential Award Mandated by law EO 448, 1997



RA No. 9013 Enacted on February 28, 2001 [REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9013]

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE PHILIPPINE QUALITY
AWARD IN ORDER TO ENCOURAGE ORGANIZATIONS
IN BOTH THE PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SECTORS TO
ATTAIN EXCELLENCE IN QUALITY IN THE
PRODUCTION AND/OR DELIVERY OF THEIR GOODS
AND SERVICES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Act shall be known and cited as the "Philippine Quality Award Act."










